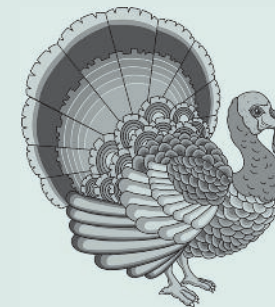

**Handicap Corner**

Your Handicap Committee is presently composed of the following individuals: John Hubner (Chairman), Joe Sansone, Emily Dell, Charles Allman, Steve Lambert (Director of Golf), and Steve Kennedy (Head Golf Professional).

The Handicap Committee has met and finished with the analysis on the North and South Course handicapping of holes. A few key factors led to our decision to change some of the existing ratings. They are:

We started the #1 rated handicap hole on the back 9 of the North because the back nine proved to be much more difficult than the front nine. Even though #18 was the most difficult hole statistically, we rated #15 as the #1 hole and made #18 our #3 handicap hole. The difficulty between the two was negligible.

Although we attempted not to let our starting and finishing holes be the #1 handicap hole, we left #1 on the South remain the #1 handicap hole because it was by far the most difficult hole in our analysis. We only made changes if there was a distinct difference in the previous rating.

We will be making these changes the next time we purchase scorecards. We anticipate that will be some time late in the year.

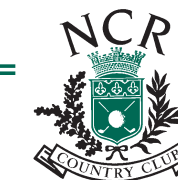
